**Observance of the 'Partition Horrors Remembrance Day'
on 14 August 2024**

It may be recalled that Hon'ble Prime Minister, in his speech on the occasion of Independence day in 2021, had declared that 14 August be observed as 'Partition Horrors Remembrance Day'. This day has been envisaged to bring to light the agony, suffering and pain of millions of people who were the sufferers of partition. It is to also sensitize the world community of the largest displacement of human population in the last century, which claimed the lives of a large number of people.

In order to showcase the sufferings of the partition affected people, an exhibition has been curated jointly by the Indian Council of Historical Research (ICHR) and Indira Gandhi National Centre for Arts (IGNCA).
