ICCR ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

The Mission organized Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) Orientation Programme in honour of Djiboutian students who have been awarded ICCR Scholarships for the Academic Year 2026-27 on July 20, 2026.

2. ICCR, a Government of India institution offers a long-term scholarship for 1503 ICCR Scholarships slots at 134 Indian Universities/Institutes to African countries under India-Africa Maitri Scholarship Scheme (IAMSS) for the Academic Year 2026-27. The students from Djibouti have been allotted 20 slots for ICCR Scholarships. The Government of India will be granting gratis visas & economy class air-fares as admissible to these ICCR scholars.

3. 20 students from Djibouti are selected for UG, PG and PhD courses under IAMS Scheme 2026-27 at various universities including Andhra University (02), Osmania University (01), University of Kerala (03), Savitribai Phule Pune University (01), Gujarat Technological University (01), Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam (01), Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda (01), Panjab University, Chandigarh (01), Mumbai University (02) Mizoram University (01), Delhi Technological University (02), University of Lucknow (01) Delhi University (02) and Jamia Millia Islamia (01).

4. On this occasion, the Ambassador of India to Djibouti H.E. M. Keivom addressed the students and motivated them to excel in their respective courses. He briefed the students about the diverse Indian culture and tourism in India. Further, he extended best wishes for their academic journey in India.

5. Embassy of India, Djibouti was opened in 2019 and since then 105 scholarships have so far been granted to Djiboutian students.
