**Things to remember at the time of application for ICCR Scholarship
Under the India-Africa Maitri Scholarship Scheme**

Djiboutian students may now apply for the ICCR scholarship for the academic year 2026-27. Details about how to apply for ICCR scholarship is as under.

ICCR Application process is an online process where the applicants will access the portal through the website is **<http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov>**.

Before beginning the process, candidate may ensure that all the education documents listed below are translated and attested by local Ministry of foreign Affairs. Candidate may keep the digital scanned copies ready to upload on the portal. The portal is opening on 23rd February 2026. ❧

Eligibility Criteria: For admission in Undergraduate level courses, it is compulsory to have 10+2 i.e; (12 years) of schooling. It is, therefore, necessary that the student applying for UG level courses must complete 12 years of schooling (Minimum age 18 years as on 01 July 2026 and maximum age 40 years for UG/PG/Diploma course and 50 years for PhD). Govt. of India has announced opportunities for students of Djibouti under the India-Africa Maitri Scholarship Scheme to avail scholarships at UG/PG/Ph.D courses.

➤ **List of Documents required to upload on A2A portal:**

- * Certified copies of mark sheets (Transcripts) [Copies of all academic qualifications, certificates and marksheet, including those relating to school leaving examination must be uploaded].
 - * Diploma certificate etc.
 - * Certified translation of the education documents in English.
 - * Copy of passport (with validity of more than 6 months). **Note:** Certified copies of relevant pages of candidate's valid passport showing photograph, name, contact details, date of issue, date of expiry and place of issue. It is appreciated if passport is valid for the duration of the course.
 - * Test scores of English standardized tests like TOEFL/IELTS may be sought by the concerned Universities.
 - * For MBA admission, GMAT test score.
 - * A recent passport size photograph not more than 3.5x4.5cm (25kb) should be uploaded on the application form in the space provided. The photograph should be with white background and without spectacles..
 - * Recommendations (02)/character certificates from existing school/Univ. etc
 - * Birth certificate OR National ID.
 - * Filled up medical fitness form (Form can be downloaded from the portal)
 - * Any other scholastic documents if available. ❧
- In case of Engineering courses, student must have Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics (PCM) in his school leaving examinations .

- **How to access A2A portal:** Application process is completely online process. The portal may be accessed at the **<http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov>**. The candidate will register and generate a user name and password. Once registered, the candidate may follow the instruction provided on the portal to upload the documents. Please note, no fields should be left empty in order to submit the application successfully. ❏
- Students are required to obtain the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) equivalence (if needed). This would be stipulated by the concerned University/ Institute in their Provisional Confirmation letter for the applicant (uploaded on Portal). In case AIU equivalence is required the student may apply for the same at the link **<https://evaluation.aiu.ac.in/student/login>** and bear the fees incurred on obtaining the certificate at their own expense (non-reimbursable).

- Interested students are advised to visit respective University / institute website regularly for courses offered, eligibility criteria and general information about the University / institute before applying for admission. The students should ensure that they are eligible for the course and meet the eligibility criteria and should submit relevant documentation as required by the Universities, in addition to the basic certificates mentioned in the application form. They are also advised to refer to the University's Handbook/University Grants Commission's website etc. Based on the choice of University, the student may familiarize him/herself with the living conditions/weather conditions of the place in which the University is located. ❏
- The admissions in Medical/ Paramedical (Nursing / Physiotherapy / anaesthesia etc. / fashion / law courses / integrated courses such as BA-LLB (5 Years) / BSC & MSC (5 Years) etc. are not admissible under the scheme. ❏
