Inauguration of Training Programme at Capacity building of the Center for Social Action and Women's Empowerment, Djibouti under the Quick Impact Project Programme of the Government of India

As a part of India's developmental and capacity building programme in Djibouti, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between Embassy of India and Ministry of Women and Family, Republic of Djibouti for the vocational training of women and girls at Center for Social Action & Women's Empowerment (CASAF) on March 24, 2021. As a part of the training programme a Kitchen was renovated with all the essentials at the CASAF center and was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Minister of Women & Family Affairs Mrs. Mouna Osman Aden in the presence of Ambassador of India Mr. Ashok Kumar on July 29, 2021.

The Government of India under the present project would provide a grant of DJF 9.03 Million to CASAF for providing vocational training to underprivileged girls and women for their socio economic empowerment and upgrading the related infrastructure. The training will benefit about 150 women. Training shall be

provided in the areas of sewing, hairdressing and cooking by trained professional trainers over a period of 50 working days for each course at the CASAF Center.

The Ambassador conveyed the Government of India's commitment to gender empowerment and equality and expressed willingness to continue cooperation with the Government of Djibouti in such areas. He also outlined that as India celebrates 75 Years of its independence, Embassy would like to collaborate more with the Ministry of Women & Family and other Ministries and Institutions of the Government of Djibouti for developmental programmes centered on socio-economic empowerment of Djiboutians. Hon'ble Minister for Women & Family Affairs Mrs. Mouna Osman Aden thanked the Government of India for this gesture.
